This program can be modified at any time by the jury and the organizer depending on the number of skiers and the weather.









INTENTION TO ENTER

✓ Each Federation, wishing to send a team to compete at the 2020 IWWF over 35 World Waterski Championships, must submit his Intention to Enter, not later than 60 days before the scheduled start of the first event, its intent to compete. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until they pay a fine of 200€ to the IWWF.

To be accepted, the "Intention to Enter" (ITE) form must be accompanied by a deposit amounting to 50€ for each athlete mentioned on the form. (For instance : 3 athletes : 3x50 = 150) This amount must be paid to the organiser and is non-refundable. Each 50€ will be deducted from the entry fee to be paid later for each athlete. If a Federation subsequently enters less athletes than declared on the ITE the fee of 50€ paid at that time is forfeited for each missing athlete.

The Federation may enter up to two more athletes than originally declared on the "Intention to Enter" form with no penalty, and for which the full entry fee is required. If more than two additional athletes participate, then a levy of **50€** per additional athlete will be payable in addition to the full entry fee.

✓ ATTENTION

The deadline for submitting the Intention to Enter is July 16,2020.





ENTRY FORM - ENTRY FEE

- ✓ The Entry Fee of the "2020 IWWF World Over 35 Waterski
 Championships" is 275€ per competitor regardless of discipline. This
 Entry Fee includes a levy of 25€ to assist towards the travel costs of
 the Official Panel.
- ✓ Each Federation shall submit his Entry Form, not later than thirty (30) days before the scheduled start of the first event, the names of the members of its team, the events each will enter, the ratings of each skier, as well as the names of the official reserves, together with the receipt of the relevant registration fee payment. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of 10€ per skier per day after the 30 days deadline to the IWWF for each skier not officially entered.
- ✓ In the event a team or individual athletes (for whom their Federation has submitted a competition entry), fail to show up for a competition their entry fee shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of the day before the start of the competition.

UNOFFICIAL TRAINING

Unofficial practice will be available between August 30th and september 13th at a cost of € 280.00 per hour, and with a minimum booking of 15 minutes. Training should be paid by bank transfer. Please submit your training requests to:

All bank charges are the responsibility of the paying party. Unofficial training will be based on a first come first serve but also consideration will be given for it to be distributed evenly based on total entries. The deadline for the unofficial practice request is end of July 2020. After July 30th, all available slots will be opened on a first come first serve basis.

OFFICIAL FAMILIARIZATION

(September 14th and 15th)

Official familiarization will be offered on Lake 1 and 2 on September 14th and 15th at a rate of € 30 per set in accordance with IWWF Rule 1.12. Please submit as a country a request to take part in familiarization by July 16th, 2020. By August 1st, a calendar will be published with the time allocated to each team and teams will have to pay their due to be able to confirm their training sets.

- Intent to Enter Form: JULY 16th
- Official Familiarization request: JULY 16th
- Official Familiarization posted: AUGUST 1st
- Entry Form: AUGUST 16th
- Official Familiarization payment: AUGUST 16th

Times will be allotted for each skier based on entries and rides. Each skier entered in the tournament will be allocated 4 slalom, 2 trick, and 3 jumps during official familiarization. A familiarization schedule will be published by August 1st, 2020. The deadline to pay for familiarization will be August 16th, 2020. Any slots unpaid by this deadline will be opened and prorated in time per country based on entries. The cost of familiarization must be paid by bank transfer. All bank charges are the responsibility of the paying party.

DOPING CONTROL

✓ In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, Doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. - The organization will provide containers for the storage of competitors'equipment.

TO ENTER FRANCE

- ✓ This information comes from the site: www.service-public.fr
- ✓ If you are European: a valid passport is enough to stay less than 90 days.
- ✓ If you are not European: you must apply for a short stay visa (90 days)

And meet the following conditions:

- ✓ Passport less than 10 years old and whose validity is at least 3 months longer on the date of your departure
- Have insurance covering medical and hospital costs
- Have sufficient resources to stay in France. Proof of hotel reservation, bed and breakfast, house rental, hospitality certificate
- ✓ We advise you to contact the French Embassy or consulate in your country to ensure that you have all the documents necessary to enter France.
